And I want you to stress these things, so that those who have trusted in God may be careful to devote themselves to doing what is good. These things are excellent and profitable for everyone. 9 But avoid foolish controversies and genealogies and arguments and guarrels about the law, because these are unprofitable and useless. 10 Warn a divisive person once, and then warn them a second time. After that, have nothing to do with them. 11 You may be sure that such people are warped and sinful; they are self-condemned. 12 As soon as I send Artemas or Tychicus to you, do your best to come to me at Nicopolis, because I have decided to winter there. 13 Do everything you can to help Zenas the lawyer and Apollos on their way and see that they have everything they need. 14 Our people must learn to devote themselves to doing what is good, in order to provide for urgent needs and not live unproductive lives. 15 Everyone with me sends you greetings. Greet those who love us in the faith. Grace be with you

# HOW TO LIVE AS A FOLLOWER OF CHRIST IN THIS WORLD

New life leads us to live a life of doing good works.

**Ephesians 2:10** For we are God's handiwork, created in Christ Jesus to do good works, which God prepared in advance for us to do.

1. Our civil life: Law abiding citizen

**Titus 3:1** Remind the people to be subject to rulers and authorities, to be obedient, to be ready to do whatever is good,

2. Our social life: Don't hurt others. Seek others' good.

**Titus 3:2** To slander no one, to be peaceable and considerate, and always to be gentle toward everyone.

3. The world without the grace of God: No care for others

**Titus 3:3** At one time we too were foolish, disobedient, deceived and enslaved by all kinds of passions and pleasures. We lived in malice and envy, being hated and hating one another.

**4. Living in God's grace**: A new life in the Spirit of God with the hope of eternal life

#### Titus 3:4-7

4 But when the kindness and love of God our Savior appeared,

- 5. The demonstration of our spiritual growth: Actively seeking to do good works
- (1) This point has to be stressed from the pulpit.

**Titus 3:8** This is a trustworthy saying. And I want you to stress these things, so that those who have trusted in God may be careful to devote themselves to doing what is good. These things are excellent and profitable for everyone.

(2) God's people must learn to serve.

**Titus 3:14** Our people <u>must learn</u> to devote themselves to doing what is good, in order to provide for urgent needs and not live unproductive lives.
